ADMISSIONS POLICIES

I. ADMISSION PRINCIPLES:

- a. The Belize Bible College encourages applications from candidates with strong academic achievement, leadership potential, a genuine interest in learning and becoming equipped with the Word of God.
- b. The College does not discriminate against applicants based on race, color, physical ability, gender, sexual orientation, religion, political beliefs, nationality, or ethnic origin.
- c. Applicants compete with each other to fill a limited number of seats; therefore, some students who meet the general requirements of the application criteria may not be accepted. Applicants who are not successful may reapply at a later time.

II. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- a. To be considered for admissions, all applicants must submit the following documents to the Office of Admissions. Applications will not be processed until the application form is completely filled out and all relevant documents are received.
 - i. Completed admissions application form.
 - ii. One (1) official transcript in a sealed envelope from all previous attended educational institutions.
 - iii. Two (2) recommendations from individuals with firsthand knowledge of the applicant's academic ability and completed on the Belize Bible College forms provided.
 - iv. Results of CXC, the ATLIB Math and English general tests or test scores on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT).
 - v. One Passport size photograph.
 - vi. The completed application form must be submitted to the Office of Admissions along with a non-refundable application fee of BZ\$75 or US \$37.50. Payment can be made in cash or credit card at the Accounts Office at the campus. Students submitting application forms by mail should use a bank draft, postal money order

or institutional check to the Belize Bible College. International students should submit payment by a bank draft or international postal money order payable in US dollars.

- vii. Maintain an agreeance with the Abstract of Principles and moral and ethical obligations as a student of the Belize Bible College outlined in the Student Code of Honor.

III. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR FRESHMEN:

A. Freshmen entering Undergraduate Programs

1. Applicants must have earned a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 out of a 4.0 grading system from their high school or junior college.

The official transcripts submitted with the application materials must verify that the applicant graduated from any four-year high school recognized by the Ministry of Education, or a U.S. regional accrediting agency.

2. Applicants must complete the ATLIB General Tests in Mathematics and English and obtain minimum scores of 26/50 for Math and 51/100 for English. The College will also accept the following:

- a. Four passes in CXC subjects which must include English and Mathematics in the place of the ATLIB general test requirement OR
- b. A combined score of 890 on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT). OR
- c. A score of 18 on the American College Test (ACT)

3. Additional Program Admission Requirements

In addition to the general requirements for admission, there are several programs that contain specific requirements for the degree plan. The Belize Bible College reserves the right to screen applicants for entry to various programs in order to ensure that they meet the necessary requirements. Applicants should make sure that they are familiar with the requirements for their specific program and that all the documentation are submitted and the necessary fees paid so that their application can be processed.

B. Admission Requirement for Bachelor's program – completion of Associates in theology degree or other accepted degree with proof of transcripts. Acceptable transfers must have a 2.0 AGPA. Must be approved by the Dean of Academic Affairs.

C. Transfer of individual courses for course credit. Application for transfer must include transcript and reasonable equivalent course offered by BBC for credit. Form must be approved by the Dean and a Transfer Fee of \$30.00 per course is will be assessed prior to the start of the semester applying for.
